

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I enroll my member for Summer 2022?

Registration is on a first come, first served basis and continues until Clubs reach capacity. Renewing members are eligible to sign up for summer membership through their Parent Portal account (part of the MyClubHub system).

New families must contact the Club of their choice to sign up for a New Family Orientation. Attending an orientation is a mandatory requirement prior to enrollment. At the orientation you will receive a tour of the Club, review important program information, and receive registration instructions.

If I end up on a waitlist, when will I be notified if my family is eligible for enrollment?

Enrollment is limited at each Club and is on a first come, first served basis. Registration will continue to be open until building capacity is full. If any openings become available, Clubs will call families on the waitlist in the order in which they are added.

Why is Club space limited?

In compliance with building capacity and to maintain safety, Clubs follow a 1:15 ratio (1 staff per every 15 youth). The safety of youth and the ability to provide adequate supervision is of utmost importance.

What if my child was a member last summer?

Please contact your Club's front desk for registration instructions for the Summer 2022 session. Only youth entering the program for the first time are required to attend a New Family Orientation.

What is the rate for those who qualify for free or reduced lunch at school?

Club summer fees are as follows:

Please note that Early Birds program fees are due in advance or at the time you sign your child in for the day.

What if I am not able to pay?

If finances are a barrier for your family, please contact your Club Director for information about payment assistance, +plans, and/or scholarships.

Will you still be offering Early Birds for an additional fee?

Yes, Early Birds is offered at each Club location from 7:30am-11:30am for an additional fee (Washington Clubhouse is 8:30am-11:30am). Please see our fee structure to determine which Early Bird fee your family will fall under.

What about enrollment for Fall 2022?

Boys & Girls Clubs register members for two sessions per year: school year and summer. Registration for the 2022-2023 school year is scheduled to open on Monday, July 25.

What about school-based sites (Fruit Valley Elementary Club and Burton Elementary Club)?

Fruit Valley Elementary and Burton Elementary school-based sites will not be open for the summer. Fruit Valley Club members are invited to sign up for summer at the Clinton & Gloria John Clubhouse. Burton Club members are invited to sign up for summer at the Heights OK 2 Clubhouse. For more information about school-based sites, please contact your Club Director.

Will any transportation be provided?
