2,675 Youth

Club members were able to attend afternoon programming during the school year and all-day programming during the summer. Nearly 600 attend daily.

1,280 Hours of Power Hour programming, where youth receive homework help and tutoring.

14,914 Meals

Club members regularly receive meals during their time at Club. Nearly 85% of Club members experience food insecurity.

86,500 Snacks

Healthy snacks are served to youth each day, which help instill healthy habits.



Long Term Positive Outcomes

Boys & Girls Clubs of America reports that across the movement, Club members with continued engagement are empowered to become adaptive learners, motivated leaders and healthy decision makers. When members have an optimal Club experience, they are equipped with skills that transfer beyond the Club walls and are more likely to succeed across three priority outcomes.

Academic Success

- 85% of youth believe they can succeed in school with 95% saying they ask for help in school when they need it.
- 77% of youth are curious to know more about science, computers, or technology while 71% communicate their emotions through art.

92% of Club members expect to graduate from high school.

63% report not “skipping” school.

Good Character & Leadership

- Each month, 75% of our members help out around the Club, while 59% volunteer in their school, neighborhood, or community.

86% of Club members feel they can stand up for what is right, even if their friends disagree.

Youth Health & Well-being

- 53% of Club members are physically active most days of the week.

90% of Club members can talk to an adult at the Club about their problems.

Life & Workforce Readiness

- 67% of Club teens feel ready to manage their finances with access to budgeting, saving, and money management programs at our Club.

69% of 11th and 12th grade Club members have participated in a career exploration program at their Club.

Enhanced Programs to Respond to the Needs of Youth

HEALTHY LIFESTYLES, ACADEMICS, CHARACTER & LEADERSHIP



Boys & Girls Clubs of Southwest Washington continues to prioritize youth physical, mental, and emotional safety and well-being. All staff are trained in PAX Tools for Human Services, a trauma-informed framework that offers tools and techniques for responding to youth behaviors. Additionally, our Behavioral Support Specialists work closely with staff to respond to incident reports and create success plans for youth.

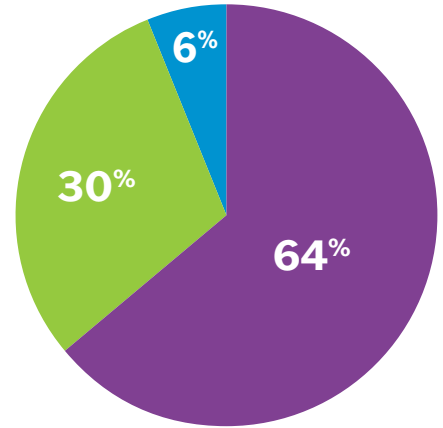
Community Working Together
